

Menu of Options

The *Formative Assessment Insights (FAI)* course, a six-month digital online learning experience for teachers, was offered during the 2015-2016 school year. The menu below offers different options for how the *FAI* experience can be tailored to individual state, district, and school needs and contexts.

FAI Introduction for Leaders & Coaches

This option is an introductory course for school leaders and coaches to prepare them to support *FAI* implementation by their teachers. *Cost: \$125 per leader/coach. Available: February 2017.*

- In addition to an orientation to *FAI* course content online, *FAI Introduction for Leaders & Coaches* includes site-based reflection protocols for coach and leader discussions around formative assessment implementation.
- *FAI Introduction for Leaders & Coaches* takes approximately three months to complete and will take place between February and May, 2017.

Online Course for Teachers

In this option, similar to last year, teacher teams with site-based coach or leader support can take *FAI* online and engage with content to implement and reflect on formative assessment practices. *Cost: \$125 per teacher. Available: 2016-2017.*

- *FAI* delivered entirely online for teachers, including virtual team discussions.
- Schools or districts register participating teachers in teams. Regular site-based support from an instructional coach or site leader is required.
- *Leaders' Lookout* (a module-by-module guide for how leaders can support teachers in implementing formative assessment in their classrooms) is provided.
- Available at any time, but recommended to start and end within the same school year.

Blended Course for Teachers

This option combines the *FAI* content with facilitated site-based Community of Practice (CoP) meetings. Detailed CoP facilitator guides are provided. *Cost: \$125 per teacher. * Available: 2017-2018.*

- *Modified FAI* course using blended learning design with two weeks of online content, two weeks of application, and one week in-person CoP meeting (CoP facilitation guides included).
- Team activities take place face-to-face at each participating school.
- Schools or districts register participating teachers in teams. Regular site-based support from an instructional coach or site leader is required.
- Introductory webinar provided for leaders and coaches.
- Available August 2017. It is recommended to start and end within the same school year. Due to an extra week in each module for CoP meetings, this version of *FAI* takes at least 7 months to complete, and should be scheduled to accommodate school vacations and holidays.

**Optional leadership and coach training provided for an additional fee (to be negotiated).*
