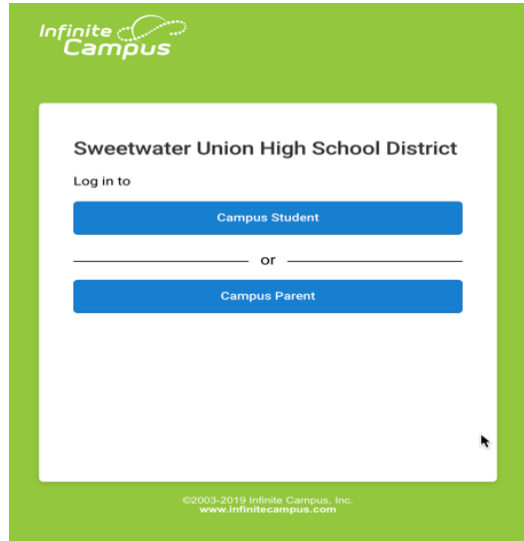
Log onto Campus Portal

Login to the **campus portal** site.

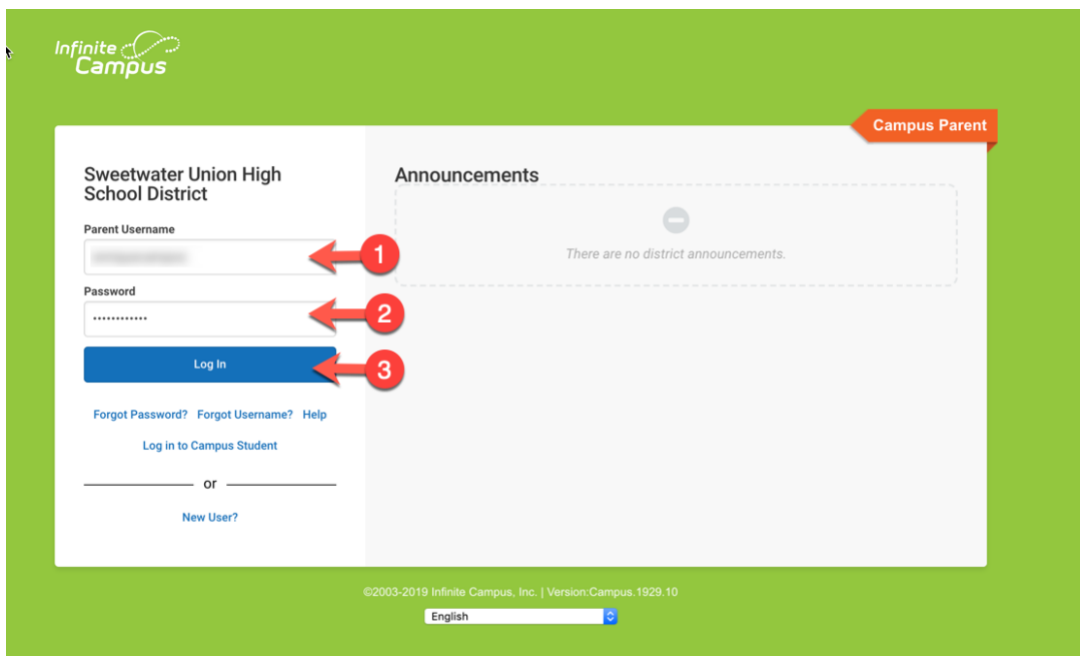

To login to the system:

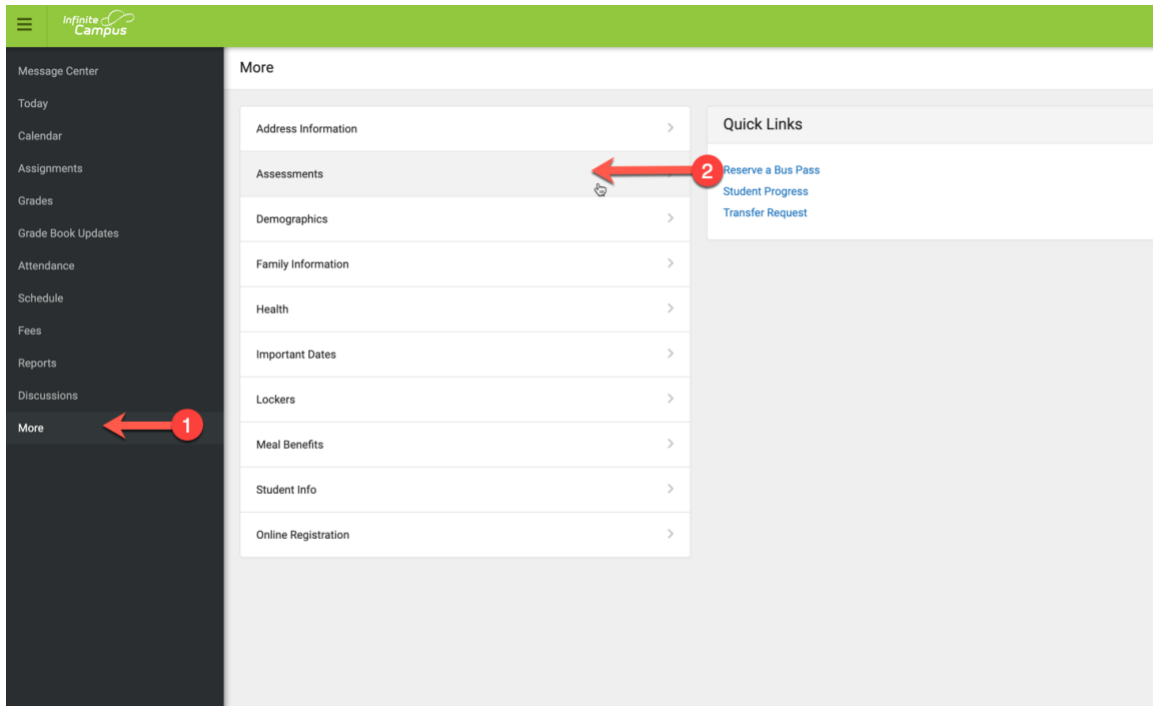
1. *Select* **Campus Student** or **Campus Parent**.



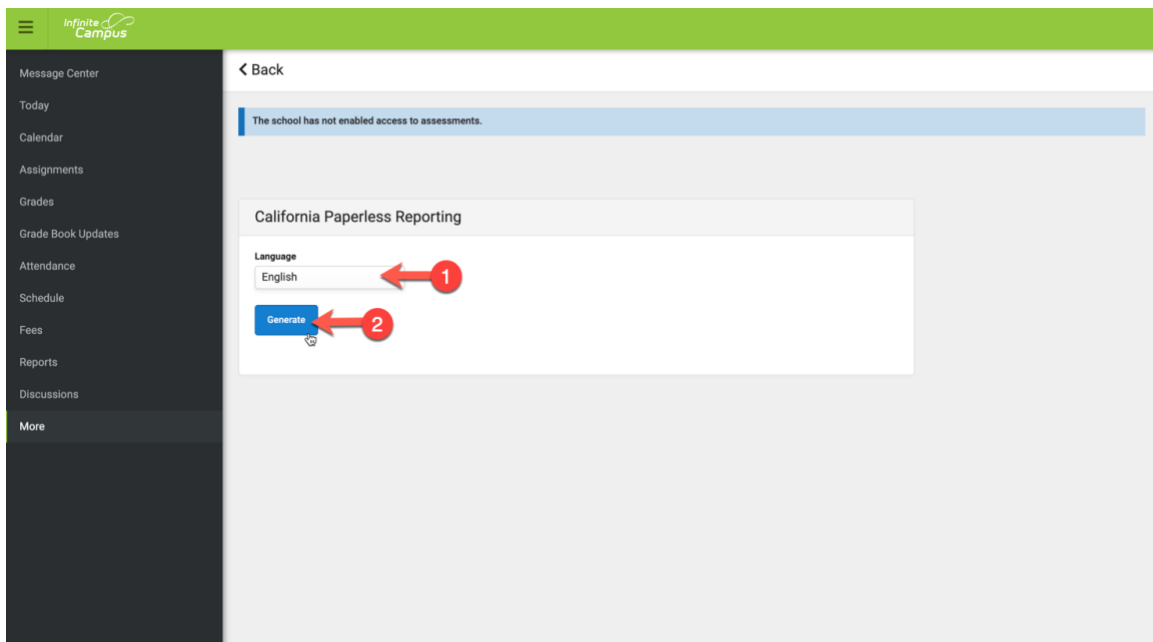
2. *Type* your **Username** and **Password**. *Click* on the **Log in** button.



3. From the menu on the top left, *click* on the **More** option and *select Assessments*.



4. *Select* your **Preferred Language**. *Click* on the **Generate**.



5. Click on **Get the report** link of the desired report.
